

The Bra Project as seen on 3-TV

This is a fun, easy project but more important it can help raise awareness of breast cancer. The bras made by Tara Hitchcock of 3-TV and Lynda Hammond, The Garage Sale Gal, went to a charity to help raise money for breast cancer research, The Rack Pack, in Tempe. So, grab your old bras..and let's get started.

Supplies:

old bras in good shape

scissors

hot glue gun

embellishments (fringe, lace, stickers) anything to decorate your bra

Directions:

Cut off straps and back of bra..leaving just cups

Glue the cups together using glue gun, leaving an opening at top.

Glue the straps back on to form the handles, these can be short or long depending on your bag style. I used the actual bra straps to keep the purse "Bra Looking" but you could swap this for a cord or ribbon. Just attach them to the top of the bra where the straps would normally sit.

Embellish the handbag by gluing on trims, ribbons and sequins to your desired style.

Add pink ribbons to a white or pink bra—or any color—in honor of Breast Cancer Awareness Month in October.

You can add a little or a lot.
