

***Make a fun garden marker or gift tag
As seen on 3-TV by the Garage Sale Gal***

Tired of those store-bought garden markers and want something more creative? Well, how about trying the Garage Sale Gal's solution to boring markers. Get a few things at your local craft store and for just pennies you have unique, hand-made tags!

Supplies:

Wooden or ceramic disks about 3" around

Paint

Glue for decoupage

print out copies of carrots, tomatoes or anything else to decorate tags with stakes, wooden or metal from hardware store

Directions:

Start by selecting the items you'll print out to decoupage onto the wooden or ceramic disks size them to no more than 2-2.5" around so they'll fit on your disk

Cut them out

Paint disks bright colors such as orange for carrots, red for tomatoes

place cut out on dried disk

decoupage (glue on) by slathering a thick layer of glue over image onto disk.

Let dry

Glue metal or wooden stake to back of marker

Stake in your garden

Use as a table name place by sticking stake into a tiny ceramic pot with dirt and flowers (how cute!!)

Drill hole into top of disk and use as a unique gift tag

However, you use the disks you'll have a one-of-a-kind tag that's fun inexpensive (about a quarter each) and cute! Have fun!
