

Tin Ceiling Tile Project

Supplies:

- 1/Foam insulation
- 2/Textured, paintable wallpaper with a tin tile design
- 3/Wallpaper paste
- 4/Kilz primer
- 5/Paint, paint brushes and sponges
- 6/Scissors, mini saw
- 7/Containers for paint, rags

Directions:

- 1/Start by cutting your wallpaper to the size tile you want
- 2/Then using the mini saw cut the foam insulation to the exact size
- 3/Glue wallpaper to foam, let dry
- 4/Prime wallpaper using the Kilz primer, let dry
- 5/Paint desired color, let dry
- 6/Add another paint color such as black, red or brown to give tile an aged look. Lightly paint on the second color then using a rag wipe it off leaving just a hint of the second color.
