Supplies:

- 1/18" grapevine wreath
- 2/black spray paint, matte
- 3/1 large crow
- 4/1 small crow
- 5/wire cutters
- 6/tacky glue



Directions:

- 1/clip and pull apart wreath to create looser appearance
- 2/spray paint entire wreath, let dry.
- 3/attach crows, bend wires at crows feet to secure
