Supplies:

an old lamp

Epoxy glue

Small round candle holder plates (glass)

Take lamp apart leaving only the middle part.

Epoxy the small round glass plate to the bottom of the lamp to keep it water tight

Then use as a vase

For a candle holder using the same supplies simply secure the small plate to the top of the lamp to form the actual candle holder.
