

MAKE A NO -SEW FLEECE

BLANKET

The Garage Sale Gal, Lynda Hammond, shows you how to make a beautiful blanket.

All it takes is some fabric, scissors and a tape measure. So, let's get started!

SUPPLIES:

- 1/One, 2-yard piece of patterned fleece
- one, 2-yard piece of solid complimentary fleece
- 2/scissors
- 3/tape measure

1/Start by cutting all the rough material off the edges of your pieces..including any ends that may have printed information on it.

2/Put the two pieces of material together (wrong sides inside, so the correct side is facing out on each side),

3/Concentrating on each of the 4 corners, cut 4, 5" square pieces out of the fabric. This will help make the corners neater.

4/Then cut 5" strips into material which are about 1" wide. Cut around entire square.

5/Then tie each piece (patterned piece and solid piece) together in a simply overhand knot (like tying a shoe lace). Be careful not to pull too hard..as it could stretch out material.

6/After all pieces are tied you have yourself a wonderful, unique blanket. So, go get a cup of tea, a good book and cuddle up with your new creation. IT'S THAT SIMPLE!!!
