

Antiqued Golden Eggs for

Easter!

Here is a really fun and easy project for Easter. It's a twist on the brightly colored Easter eggs we see each year. All it takes is a few supplies and a bit of time. So, let's get started.

Supplies:

All supplies can be purchased at craft stores.

Gold leaf paper

Soft bristled paint brush

red acrylic paint

wooden eggs

adhesive glue

1/ Paint the eggs red and let dry completely

2/Apply a coat of the dry adhesive with a brush

3/Let the shine disappear from the surface of the eggs, then wrap the gold leaf around it using gentle brush strokes. Smooth surface as you brush. Let dry.

The red paint will show thru slightly to create an antiqued look.
